 - Opportunities for Collaboration with the Grow Asia Network

Production and Approached to Smallholder Farmers Profit Guarantee were also presented.

While the COVID-19 pandemic has disrupted the ability to convene meetings in person, the increasing comfort of using virtual platforms has increased the number and diversity of attendees to the Forum, added richness to the Forum discussions.

The International Institute of Rural Reconstruction (IIRR)

Food System-related Initiatives in Myanmar Webinar, organized by the International Institute of Rural Reconstruction (IIRR), IDRC, and CIAT, was held on 3rd July 2020. The Webinar is the second in a series of conferences on Understanding Inclusive, Healthy, and Sustainable Food Systems for Policy and Practice in Myanmar.

Discussion topics included

- a) the Food System in the rural area and why it matters
- b) integrating nutrition, food security, and gender in Climate Resilient Agriculture Programming: Case of Myanmar Climate-Smart Villages;
- c) leveraging agriculture education in Myanmar to advance sustainable food systems and the challenges and opportunities in the value chain of food in Myanmar were discussed at length at the event.

Snapshot Briefing: Rapid Market Assessments of Five Agricultural Value Chains in Myanmar

During the COVID-19, many farmers, labourers, SMEs, and agri-business companies have been severely affected by the impacts of the virus and the restrictions needed to curb the spread. Effective responses to the COVID-19 pandemic and the economic recovery of the agricultural sector will require a strong and more specific understanding of how key value chains are sustained, coordinated, and innovated.

This ‘Snapshot Briefing’ is compiled by Myanmar Agriculture Network (MAN), AgriProFocus (APF), and ICCO Cooperation to highlight some of the important dynamics, challenges, and space for interventions occurring in five key value chains in Myanmar. It is not meant to be comprehensive but meant to offer entry points for further multi-stakeholder engagement, coordination, and tailored actions.
